Grade 6

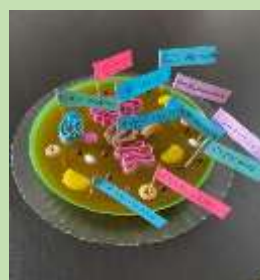
Geography
