The reopening of school brought a lot of cheer and excitement to the students. The academic year started with a number of exciting activities to set the pace.

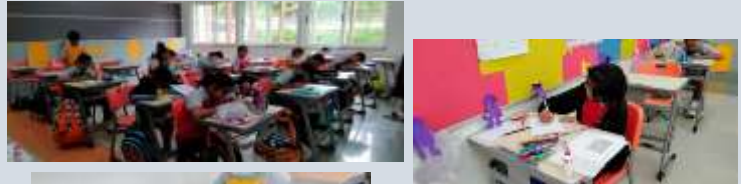
Cave Paintings

Math
